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# **Mr Stark's Messages - 5.1.24**


READY, RESPECTEUL, SAFE

#### **PARKING**

There has been a marked improvement in parking since my last letter. We are now focussing on only 4 or 5 repeat offenders. More deterrents are being ordered just in case some people are unable to see the bright red and yellow no parking police cones.

Yellow zig-zag lines outside schools, hospitals, or fire, police or ambulance stations indicate the length of road where stopping or waiting is strictly prohibited.
